Dear Friends

There is a wordsearch about the mustard seed of faith in this magazine. A mustard seed is very small, about like a fleck of ground pepper. It eventually grows into a substantial shrub. The Bible puts emphasis on small things, which can have big consequences. The stories in the Bible are about ordinary people, who through God's grace, when they carry out even a small kind action, it can lead the way to even greater fruitfulness.

We can have many years of learning through our life experiences. True riches are not what you have in the bank but what you have in your character. during her long reign. 'Pray for me...that God may give me wisdom and strength to carry out the solemn promises I shall be making, and that I may faithfully serve Him and you, all the days of my life' was her prayer request made in her first Christmas broadcast in 1952.

As we reflect on those people who have given us wisdom and guidance; the people who really listened to you. Remember how they gave you words of hope and encouragement. Perhaps we lack such people in our lives and it is difficult to find a purpose or meaning to our lives a times. Can we be an encourager? As a Christian community, we may come together to worship on a Sunday but what is more critical, is how by our small actions, our encounters and extending our fellowship more widely, we also hope to be like the 'Good Samaritan' in that parable. To perhaps offer a listening ear, to be considerate and non-judgemental as we extend the hand of friendship and fellowship. Jesus is our ultimate role model. He went about his community, offering love, his presence, guidance and wisdom. He was compassionate, generous and through his teachings, He offered healing and forgiveness. With small actions, and great love we can achieve much together. God Bless you; Rev'd Julie James

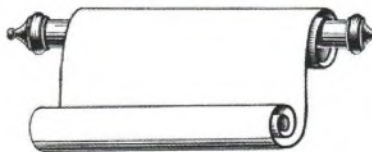

### **Money For Ukraine**

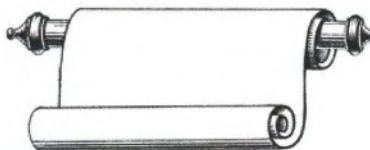

## Recipe of the month – October

### Ginger and Pear Crumble

A glut of conference pears and a prompt from a friend have encouraged me to update and repeat a favourite recipe.

#### Ingredients

About 6 conference pears  
Several 'nibs' of crystallised stem ginger  
½ lemon (juice and 'shell')  
2 tablespoons of golden syrup  
Water – enough to cover pears  
Cornflour to thicken  
Crumble mix – best made with butter  
A sprinkle of demerara sugar

#### Method

Wash, peel, core and cut several pears, about 1 lb (454 gm), into small pieces. Place in a pan with the juice of half a lemon and enough water to cover. (Throw in the lemon skin and remove later). Add a good dollop of golden syrup and several 'nibs' of crystallised ginger cut into small pieces. Poach until pears are softened. Cool, drain and place into a suitable ovenproof dish. Thicken the juice with cornflour and pour over the fruit. Cover with crumble mix and sugar. Bake in a moderate oven until golden brown. Serve with cream, ice cream or custard.

PS After cooking the fruit and cooling, it can be frozen ready to defrost and complete with the crumble mix at a later date,

## Linking Lives

### Addressing loneliness together in moments we encounter each other

It is widely recognised there is a difference between loneliness and social isolation. Social isolation is the absence of social contact, whilst loneliness is a feeling of sadness or anxiety when someone needs company. Each of us respond differently to feeling alone and over the past two years we have witnessed how loneliness can have a devastating impact on our health and wellbeing.

Linking Lives UK is a national Christian charity, motivated to address loneliness by being alongside Churches, who are connecting with people facing loneliness in their neighbourhoods. Linking Lives UK befriending approach significantly changed due to the pandemic, as social distancing restrictions meant no visiting befriending could take place. Linking Lives UK responded by launching 'Two's Company' telephone befriending framework and over the pandemic, many churches across the UK partnered with Linking Lives UK, as a way of responding to the loneliness crisis, with their volunteers becoming telephone befrienders.

Moving beyond the pandemic, Linking Lives UK are developing innovative ways churches can grow their social action around loneliness. A recent pilot was launched to support church volunteers develop their skills in loneliness awareness conversation, to be used as they help out in foodbanks, coffee morning or other hosted activities. The 'Good Conversation' concept is in an addition to the telephone and visiting befriending frameworks. It is a resource for churches wanting to partner with Linking Lives and explore how they can address loneliness for people in their parishes. Other resources can be located on the website [www.linkinglives.uk](http://www.linkinglives.uk) including the 'Power of One', a unique resource when talking to those facing isolation.

Carol our West Midlands Area Development Officer is currently welcoming ideas, as to how we can begin conversations in Worcestershire, with churches or individuals wishing explore how to address loneliness together. Looking after several churches, being on many different committees including being a school governor for our two local schools, engaging in a large wedding ministry, plus occasional offices like funerals and baptisms, means that my working week is very busy.

The Pastoral Visitor is Mrs Cathy Powell-Chandler. Part of her role is to co-ordinate pastoral visitors within our church communities. If you would specifically like me to visit you, then please indicate this by contacting me direct or via one of the church officers, all details of which are in the magazine. In a caring community, we all look to see whether our neighbours need or wish to accept our help.

**Weddings-Please check the website. [www.berrowbenefice.org.uk](http://www.berrowbenefice.org.uk)**

**At present, we are holding church two church services each Sunday. Please check for details on the website or contact us.** For the 'qualifying attendance' to be married in a church, you need to attend for 6 months, once a month.

### **How we get you legally wed**

We are legally entitled to marry you in a Church of England church through the publication of banns, read 3 times before the wedding date. We ask you to contact your local parish church and arrange when the banns are to be read 3 times there too. A **Marriage Document** is now signed at the church ceremony since the rules changed on May 4<sup>th</sup> 2021 and then you apply for a Marriage Licence through the **Worcester Registry Office**. We will give you all the details.

### **Common License**

In very special cases, you can apply for a Common License to marry with us. Please do seek an early explanation and the process involved.

### **Civil Ceremony followed by a Blessing in Church**

If you are unable to attend for 6 months to qualify, then you could have Registrar a civil ceremony first. We can then offer you a Church blessing of your marriage which is as similar to a full wedding as we can make it.

## Conclusion

Rev'd Anthea and I are ready to help you during this decision making process. Please do discuss the options with us and your wedding venue hosts. We do try to meet your expectations and make this a special day. Do try and attend our marriage preparation day. We try to answer your questions, look at the wedding day itself and looking ahead to the future.

## **Eldersfield Cricket Club – End-of-Season News** **by Dereck Hartland**

It has been a disappointing end to the Cricket Season for Eldersfield, losing two of their last three matches. Consequently finishing second behind Champions Aston Ingham 2nds in the Premier Division of the Cheltenham/Gloucester/Forest of Dean league.

Things started to go wrong at Woodmancote when your Roving Cricket Correspondent missed the turning for the Woodmancote ground and ended up late once again. On eventually finding the ground he was told that one of Eldersfield's star players on setting out decided to have a fight with the pavilion wall, resulting in a win for the wall and the unfortunate player missing the rest of the season with a broken hand! On the field only Leo Rendall Baker 46 not out showed the application required to reach Woodmancote 2nds total of 161-7 as Eldersfield finished 44 runs short on 117-8.

The last home game saw Westbury-on-Severn 2nds score 185-5, a total Eldersfield never looked likely to reach, especially when they were 26-5 and only an entertaining unbeaten last wicket stand of 36 between two of Eldersfield's stalwarts Hughie Jones and Andy Houldey saw Eldersfield to 128-9 and a couple of batting points.

At least Eldersfield managed to win the last game of the season at Forest Exiles. Batting first, Eldersfield were bowled out for 153, George Bunn top scoring on 54. He then took 3-32 and helped by James Bullock 3-15 and spin-ball wizard Leo Rendall Baker 3-20 bowled Forest Exiles out for 127.

So looking back on the season, second place in a higher league was a good performance by Eldersfield and the narrow one run defeat to Champions Aston Ingham 2nds proved very costly. But this is still a young Eldersfield team and if they can stick together who knows, they might go one better next year.

### **Wednesday 5 October 2022**

#### **ICI**

*Bryan Smith. Retired Director of Engineering for ICI.*

The theme of this talk, which had to be postponed because of Covid last year, is as much about the precipitous decline of manufacturing in Britain in recent years, as it is just about ICI itself.

Bryan Smith, who used to be ICI's Director of Engineering, will use the disappearance of this once famous name as a lesson on what has gone wrong in the past. Hopefully this will stimulate some discussion about what needs to be changed if Britain is ever again to regain its role as 'workshop of the world', or anything approaching self-sufficiency.

### **Wednesday 12 October 2022**

#### ***The Psychology of Health***

*David Smallwood. David holds a formal qualification in health psychology and has run courses for private individuals and health professionals.*

This is a brief introduction to the psychology of health. It will explain the contribution we can make to our own health through the way we think about it and the choices we make. There will be included humorous anecdotes, video clips and an information sheet to take away.

### **Wednesday 19 October 2022**

#### ***Title Tidal Power as a Source of Green Energy***

*Mike Wilkinson. Mike is an ecologist by training and worked on the Severn Tidal Power feasibility study (2008-10). For three years Mike was Senior Planning Officer for RSPB Cymru working on RSPB's response to tidal energy proposals and renewable energy policy in Wales.*

A tidal barrage for the Severn Estuary was first mooted over a hundred years ago but has never been built. Previous proposals have all failed to mature because the cost was too high. Given high energy prices, can tidal power now contribute to the green energy mix needed to avert climate change?

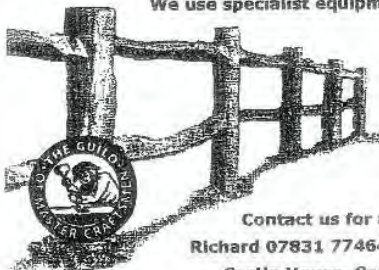

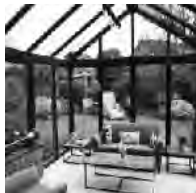

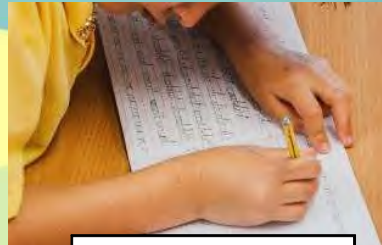
